St. Fachtna's Cathedral, Rosscarbery



St. Fachtna's Cathedral, Rosscarbery has a superb ring of 6, and having adjustable sound control, are readily available for all to ring! The Cathedral is also the only tower in Ireland containing a ring of bells to have a ringers' gallery, from which ringing of bells takes place in full view of those entering or leaving the Cathedral.

St Fachtna's Cathedral is in the centre of Rosscarbery a busy market town in west Cork, on the N71.

There is no regular ringing at present but please contact Diana Pitcher if you are visiting and wish to ring or arranging an outing
