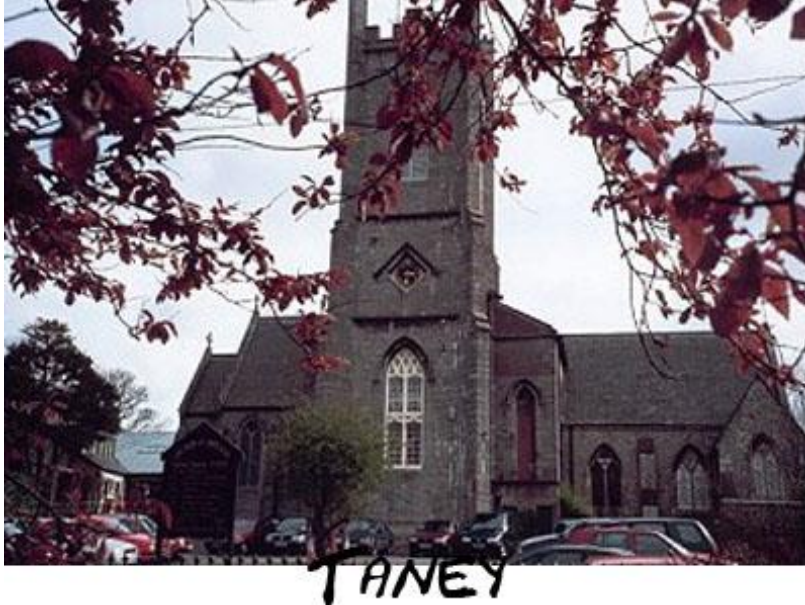




Tower History

Christ Church, Taney



The parish church of Christ Church Taney in Dundrum was originally opened in 1818, although it did not have any bells until the year 2000.

The actual bells were originally cast for St George's Church in Dublin city centre. When the church was closed, the bells were put into storage for almost 10 years.

As a millennium project, the bells were installed in their present location and were first rung out on New Year's Day.
