Kilmood is a light 6 installed by Martin Hough, very like the installation at Dunmanway in Co. Cork. It was amazing that all 17 new ringers stayed the course. Helped perhaps by the link to the Centenary of WW1 for which they were dedicated as “The Peace Bells”.
