

Dear Fiona,

Following our recent correspondence in relation to the Irish Association, I attach 3 documents related to suggested changes.

At the 2022 IACR AGM meeting, it was agreed to review the rules of the IACR as they needed to be contemporary and more consistent in formatting. In addition, there were one or two rules which required updating. A committee Appointed by the President, comprising Mike Pomeroy, Julia Lysaght, Andrew White, Fiona Chamberlain, Nigel Pelow, Don McLean and Ian McCullough met on two occasions (27/11/2022 and 11/11/2022).

The results of the meetings showed that, in the best opinion of the committee, changes to certain rules were required. Based on these opinions, the Committee proposes the amendments to the Association rules given in the document **“Proposed changes to RULES OF ASSOCIATION 2023”**. This document shows suggested changes in bold font where **additions** to the text have been made and suggested **deletions** in bold font with strike out.

The reasonings behind the suggested rule amendments are given in the document **“Proposed changes to RULES OF ASSOCIATION 2023 – reasonings”**.

This document contains 5 motions relating to different importances of the rules. It is however proposed to the IACR Executive Council by Mike Pomeroy and seconded by Don McLean.
