



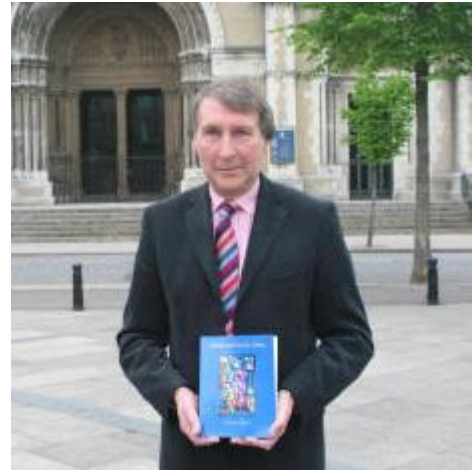
Honorary Life Member Citation

Duncan Scarlett

Duncan has had a long ringing career, having started ringing in 1951. He served in a number of positions within St Thomas' tower, latterly serving as the conductor and ringing master.

After retirement from work, Duncan has devoted an enormous amount of his time to ringing in his own tower and further afield. At one point he was ringing master at St Thomas' and deputy ringing master at Hillsborough at the same time!

Duncan has given excellent service to the IACR as Northern District Ringing Master and then as Association Ringing Master. In these capacities he organised a number of highly successful and well attended trips to Liverpool and London, which gave new opportunities in ringing to many of our members.



Duncan has written a number of books on church architecture all of which discussed bell ringing and so increased the profile of ringing.

During his leadership, St Thomas' has had a successful period of activity winning the Attendance Shield, the Cunningham Cup and the Murphy Cup.
